P.A.C.K. is a non-profit organization chartered in October 1976. Our mission is to provide support and services with the Kern County Probation Department, enabling people to become productive members of the community.

Through income generated by contributions and annual fundraisers, such as Photos with Santa and the Annual Fog Run, P.A.C.K. provides materials and services. These include educational, recreational, and social materials and supplies, personal necessities and emergency assistance. P.A.C.K. benefits all units and institutions of the Juvenile Division of the Probation Department as well as adults within the AB109 (prison realignment) population.

BRIDGES ACADEMY ART PROGRAM

P.A.C.K provides financial support to the Bridges Career Development Academy Art Program. While growing academically, students are also provided with the opportunity to express themselves through various artistic mediums.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Scholarship Fund is an opportunity for financial support toward educational goals and is available to individuals on juvenile and adult probation. Applicants are nominated by their Probation Officers and are required to submit proof of registration in a college or trade school.

TAKE AWAY TATTOOS

The TAT program, implemented in 1998, provides no-cost tattoo removal treatment for juveniles and adults on Probation. Recently we have expanded service to include the AB109 population. This program has received an award from the California Probation, Parole and Correctional Association and continues to change lives.

I'M THUMBODY

I'm Thumbody is a self-esteem building and bullying prevention campaign aimed at elementary school students. This is an interactive program in which the students are encouraged to participate in class discussion with the assistance of visual aids and take-home materials.
