


Total Public Defender case appointments decreased 6.9% from 1st to 2nd Qtr. FY 14/15, excluding Juvenile (Dependency and Delinquency) and Conservatorship appointments. However, Public Defender workload remains up by 26.1% compared to the same period in FY 11/12, which coincided with Realignment's introduction. Thus, the relative current decrease exists amidst the backdrop of a continued, significant elevated workload, when measured against pre-Realignment totals.



Overall Department Summary:

4th quarter Ridgecrest felony and misdemeanor and 3rd quarter Ridgecrest misdemeanor numbers are upwardly skewed. For the first eight months of FY 14-15, the department experienced acute clerical staffing issues in Ridgecrest which likely effected CJIS case tracking and inputting. Working through the backlog appears to reflect a disproportionately high workload in the 3rd and 4th quarters, together with associated undercounting in earlier quarters.
