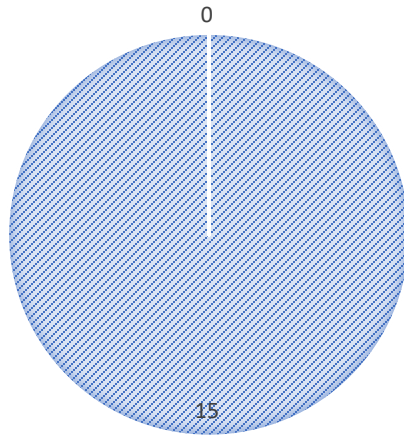
6) Next Subcommittee Meeting

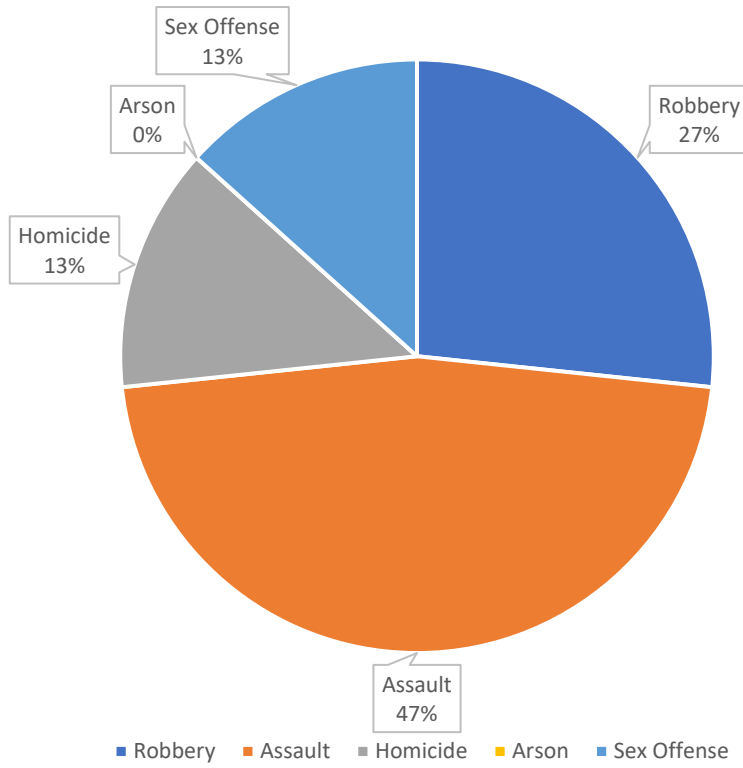

■ Male ■ Female

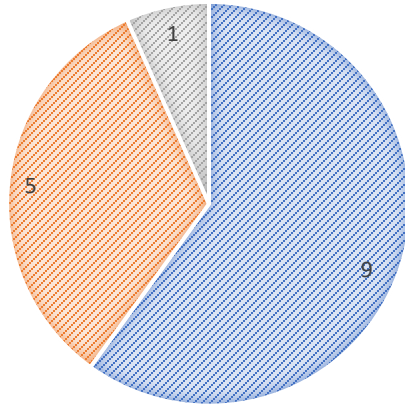


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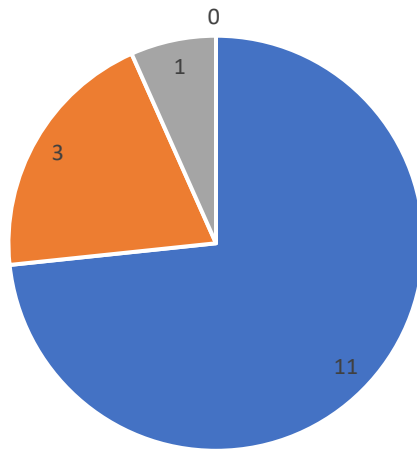
AGE RANGE

■ Under 18 ■ 18-21 ■ Over 21

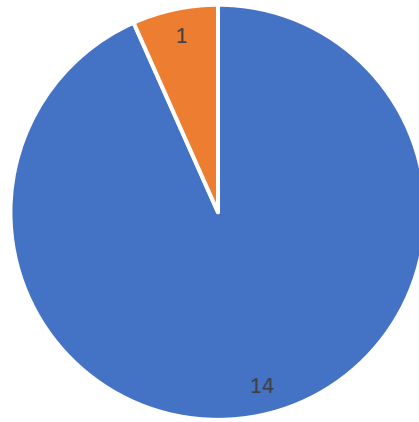


Race
