## **POLICY**

The following criteria will be used when dismissing cases:

- A. The minor's term of probation has expired.
  - Felony Cases The minor has successfully completed all terms and conditions of probation and has been out of custody for a minimum of one year.
  - 2. Misdemeanor Cases The minor has successfully completed all terms and conditions of probation and has been out of custody for a minimum of six months.
- B. If it is felt a case has exceptional circumstances and should be dismissed sooner, the case should be submitted for dismissal with an explanation to the Court.
